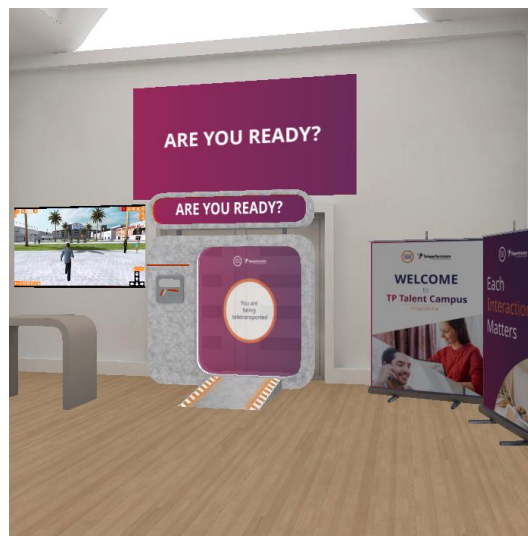

RECEPTION AREAS

1. Backstage

Reception room, arranged to help users to make a first contact and configure their devices, in addition to reporting on the event.



It has:

- 2 roll-ups.
- 2 banners.

2. Corporate World

Main stage, a meeting place or hall for visitors. It houses several buildings, screens and areas to present the company and branding.



It has:

- 7 buildings (3 large and 4 small on each side)
- Board games area
- A videowall



SPEECH & PRESENTATION AREAS

3. Amphitheater

Stage directed to massive conferences with a capacity intended for about 200 people. Structures capable of giving the option to do round tables or question and answer rounds.



It has:

- A main screen and two auxiliaries (one on each side).
- 3 areas for general public.
- 2 seats on stage to organize round table or enable several speakers.
- Speaker lectern with microphone for the whole room to hear.



4. Auditorium

Stage for large conferences with a capacity for 200 persons.



It has:

- Access to the corporate world.
- 3 areas for general public.
- Large display screen and 2 small ones.
- Speaker's stand with microphone for 2D voice



5. Conference Room

Stage with two spaces divided into two rooms: one of them designed for developing skills, role-playing activities and encouraging participation and user communication, and another that serves as a meeting room.



It has:

- Table with 18 seats and 3 screens (one with a centered lectern) and two auxiliaries
- Another adjoining room where you can carry out complementary activities



6. Meeting Room

Multipurpose space with multiple areas for small meetings, presentations and group conversations.



In the outer area it has:

- 4 private areas for conversations of up to 8 people.
- Ground floor next to pool with 6 bench areas.

In the interior it has:

- Meeting table with lectern and presentation screen.
- Chillout area.

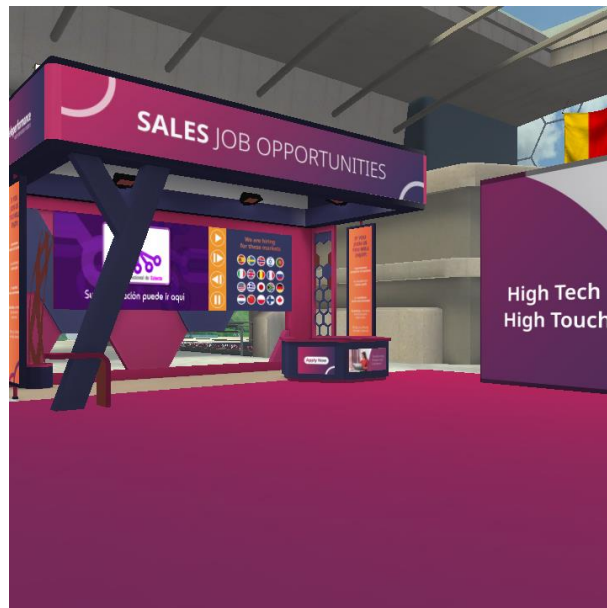




BOOTH AREAS

7. Arena

Stage with capacity for 250 users. Built to hold fairs up to 30 customizable stands.



8. Pavilion

Great stage with capacity for 200 users. Built to hold fairs, forums and congresses with space for more than 40 customizable stands..



It has:

- Networking areas.
- Large 4-sided audiovisual screen



9. Lincoln Memorial

Outdoor stage built to hold fairs up to 20 customizable stands.

10. Networking

Diaphanous stage with several meeting spaces and board games, for informal meetings.



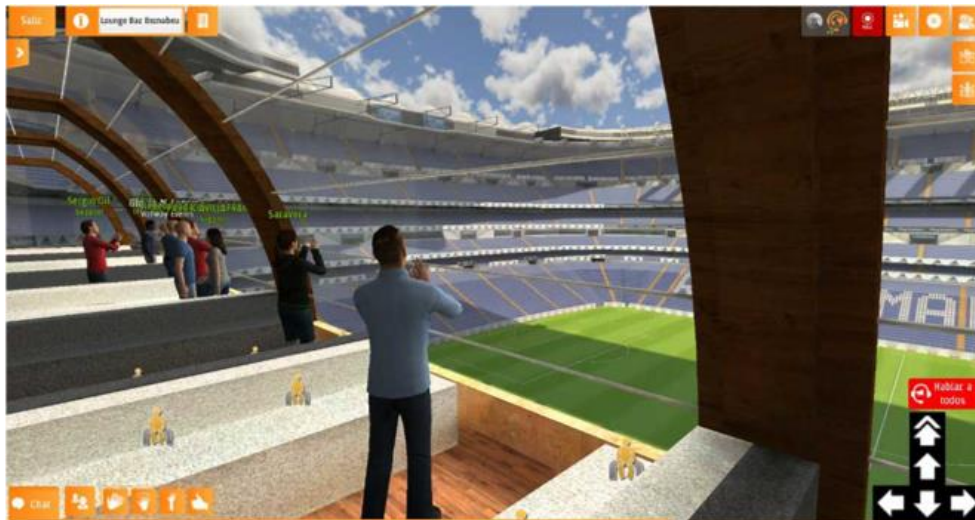
It has an outdoor area with several cabins for private meetings.



In addition, a large interior area with sofas.

11. Lounge Bar

Space that represents a place designed for networking and interactivity between users who are on the same stage. This space shows a modern and useful environment to talk in a group or interact with other characters.



This area has:

- 8 areas with 6 seats in a circular shape in the middle of the room.
- 8 zones of 8 opposite seats
